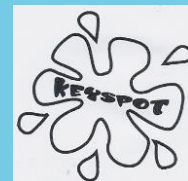

CAMP KEYSLOT IS OPEN ALL SUMMER

We recognize the needs of the Murwood community. We are open all summer. Camp hours are 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM, Monday through Friday. Camp begins Monday, June 12 and ends Friday, August 18, 2017. The only day we close during the summer is July 4th, 2017, in observation of Independence Day.

REGISTRATION

Registration begins April 1st, 2017. Registration fees for Camp Keyspot 2017 are \$50 per child or \$75 per family. **Registration fee will double after 6/1/2017.** Who can attend? Campers who are enrolled to attend any grade from TK to 10th for the Fall 2017 term are eligible to attend summer camp at Keyspot. Murwood students receive priority registration.

CAMPER SCHEDULES

Camper schedules are due with registration, by June 1st, 2017. Any changes or additions made to a schedule after June 1st will be subject to higher rates and additional charges. After a schedule is in place, Keyspot must know 2 weeks prior if cancellations are to be made. Failure to cancel 2 weeks ahead will result in the account being charged in full, regardless of attendance.

SUMMER PROGRAM

What do your camp fees pay for? We are glad you asked! 55 hours of quality care from staff you know and trust. 25 hours of structured activity time filled with fun and enriching choices. 6 hours of adult supervised pool time with professional lifeguards. 3 nutritious snacks daily. Plenty of time to hang out with friends. An indoor facility with all the comforts of home!

CUSTOM SOLUTIONS

Camp Keyspot is designed to suit your summer child care needs. Schedule choices include full weeks, full days, and half days. Half day options include the AM option of 8:30 AM to 12:30 PM OR the PM option of 12:30 PM to 4:30 PM. Half days are ***not available*** on Wednesdays.

CAMPER DISCOUNTS

Fees go up after June 1, 2017. Sibling discount of 10% for additional siblings. Students entering 6^h grade or higher may qualify for the C.I.T. camper rate.

CAMPERS

The campers attending Keyspot are assigned to a group color based on their grade level. While attending off-site activities, campers travel with these groups and a specifically assigned teacher.

DAILY ACTIVITIES

Activities are the core of our summer program. Camp staff collaborate and plan themed activities to our camper's interests and requests. Our well-rounded summer includes structured sports and other physical activities, science, fine arts, crafts, dance, dramatic play, cooking, and technology offerings. Staff members also create their own specialty clubs that are on-going throughout the summer.

SWIMMING AT CAMP KEYSPT

Clarke Memorial Swim Center at Heather Farms Park is nestled in the gorgeous Heather Farm Park/Community Center in Walnut Creek. Keyspot will take a quick bus ride from our site to the swim center and enjoy our afternoon swimming! There is a large, heated baby pool that goes to 3 ½ feet for our younger campers. There are also two other large pools, one with a diving board, for stronger swimmers. We will head to this swim center on Tuesdays.

Diablo Valley Recreation Association (known as D.V.R.A) is a quick ½ mile, 15-minute walk which takes campers to a private recreation pool where they can cool their heels in the baby pool or perfect their cannonball off the diving board in the heated larger pool. Private swim lessons are available to Keyspot campers during our time at D.V.R. A. These are offered by the amazing Diana O'Rourke and can be scheduled prior to the beginning of camp. FIELD TRIPS

Each Wednesday, campers attend an offsite field trip (except for Week 10; we will be hosting an onsite carnival). All Wednesday trips are age-appropriate and tons of fun. Transportation is provided by Mt. Diablo Unified School District or other private school bus.

Camp Keyspot provides three nutritional snacks daily. Lunch is not provided unless otherwise noted in the weekly flyer. Please be sure to provide you camper(s) with nutritional lunch items. It is highly recommended that campers bring a reusable water bottle labeled with their name.
