Camp Fees

Our registration fee is \$55 per child, \$80 per family. The following fees are in addition to registration and are all inclusive.

Weekly and Daily Fees for Registration received by May 31, 2019: \$320 per week (Mon-Fri, 7am-6pm); Monday(7am-6pm): \$80; Tuesday(7am-6pm) \$85; Wednesday(7am-6pm): \$130; Thursday(7am-6pm): \$85; Friday(7am-6pm): \$80.

Half Day Rates: Half Day AM (Mon and Fri, 7am-12:30pm): \$55/each; Half Day PM (Mon and Fri, 12:30 PM-6:00PM): \$55/each; Half Day AM (Tue and Thu, 7AM-12:30PM): \$55/each; Half Day PM (Tue and Thu, 12:30pm-6pm): \$60/each.

Fees after June 1st will increase to: \$355 per week; Mon and Fri Full Day \$87.50/each; Wed Full Day is \$142.50; Tue and Thu Full Day is \$93/each. Half Day AM (Mon and Fri, 7AM-12:30PM): \$60/each; Half Day PM (Mon or Fri, 12:30 PM-6PM) \$60/each; Half Day AM (Tue and Thu, 7AM-12:30PM) \$60.50/each; Half Day PM (Tue and Thu, 12:30pm-6pm) \$65.50/ each.

Camp Keyspot is Open All Summer!

Camp hours are 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM, Monday through Friday. Our summer program begins Monday, June 10th and ends August 9th, 2019. We are closed July 4th & 5th in observation of Independence Day.

Registration and Schedule Details

Campers who are enrolled to attend any grade from TK to 10th in the Fall of 2018 are eligible to attend summer camp at Keyspot. Murwood students receive priority. Registration begins in April. The \$55 per child or \$80 per family registration fee will double for ALL registration packets turned in after June 1st, 2019. Camper schedules are due with registration. Changes and additions made on or after June 1st will have the rate increase mentioned on the previous page. After a schedule is in place, Keyspot must know in writing 2 weeks prior if cancellations are to be made. Failure to do so will result in the account being charged in full, regardless of attendance.

Summer Program

Daily Activities: Activities are the core of our summer program. Camp staff collaborate and plan themed activities based on careful observation of our camper's interests. Our summer program includes a wide range of activities, including sports, science, fine arts, crafts, dance, dramatic play, cooking, and technology. There are also staff-hosted specialty clubs that are on-going throughout the summer.

Swimming with Camp Keyspot: Diablo Valley Recreation Association (known as D.V.R.A.) is a private recreation pool located a ½ mile from Keyspot. Campers can cool their heels in the baby pool, enjoy time with friends in the larger heated pool, or perfect their cannonball off the diving board. Murwood's own Diana O'Rourke offers private swim lessons onsite. Schedule in advance on the Parent Info Board. Contact Diana via email: po1111@astound.net or phone: (925)938-2109.

The pool at Walnut Knolls is located just around the corner from Keyspot at Walnut Knolls park. Campers will enjoy swimming in one of two pools depending on skill level. Children may also enjoy the playground and park adjacent to the pools- just in case a game of soccer or playing in the sand is more your camper's style.

Field Trips: Each Wednesday, campers attend an offsite field trip. All Wednesday trips have been assessed for developmental appropriateness and are sure to be tons of fun. Transportation is provided by a chartered bus service covered by our insurance.

Food: Camp Keyspot provides three nutritional snacks daily. Campers are required to bring their own lunch unless otherwise noted in the weekly flyer. Please be sure to provide your camper(s) with nutritional lunch items. It is highly recommended that campers bring a reusable water bottle labeled with their name.
